Boarders Complaints Policy

If you are worried or unhappy or have a complaint to do with school or you need to talk to someone then contact any of the people listed below who will listen and try to help you.

- 1 BOARDERS PREFECT: SCHOOL PREFECTS: HOUSE CAPTAINS etc.**
Perhaps your problem can easily be sorted out by one of the older girls.
Choose someone you can trust and ask her to listen to you.

- 2. SCHOOL STAFF in Lower or Upper School or Boarding House.**
Talk to the person who you feel will understand your situation best. It need not be one of your Form Teachers. Ask for a suitable time to speak privately. If it is urgent say so.

- 3. CHILD PROTECTION OFFICER**
If you need to talk to someone about a Child Protection issue because someone - either another pupil or a member of staff, or someone outside of school – is abusing, bullying or generally being very unkind to you then ask to speak to Miss Gooderson. If she is not on site then Sr Danuta, Francis or Mrs Kenny will listen to you.

- 4. AN INDEPENDENT LISTENER.**
It may be that you cannot reveal your problem to anyone in school, nor to your parents. If this is the case either ring:
